**ORDINANCE NO. 1431**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO 1367, AND ARTICLE XI, SECTION XI-1 E. OF THE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**


**SECTION 1.** The following shall repeal and replace Article XI, Section XI-1 E. of the Personnel Regulations for the Employees of the City of Columbus, Kansas.

**SECTION 2.** **New Section XI-1 E. Employees who terminate employment voluntarily, whose separation is accepted or approved by the Governing Body, but deemed not in good standing, may be precluded from ongoing or future employment, volunteer or reserve positions which may compensate the individual.**

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
