ORDINANCE NO. 1466

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING EMERGENCY POWERS AND AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCIES AFFECTING PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE AND FOR THE PROTECTION OF CITY RESIDENTS AND CITY EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That in circumstances affecting the public health and welfare of citizens and employees of the City of Columbus, Kansas, the Governing Body of Columbus, Kansas, hereby authorizes emergency powers to the Mayor or designee, to timely respond to all aspects of emergencies including, but not limited to health emergencies, utility services and weather related disasters.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, and the Ordinance shall be published once in the official City newspaper.

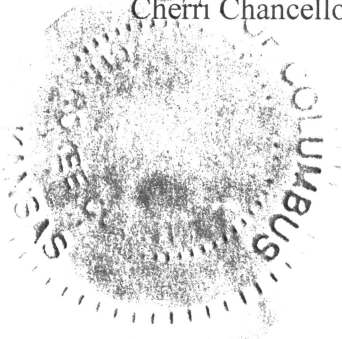
