

RESOLUTION NO. 527

A resolution by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, adopting the Cherokee County Neighborhood Revitalization Plan through an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Columbus, Kansas, and Cherokee County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan established by the Governing Body of Cherokee County, Kansas, by its Resolution No. 06-2018, creates incentives for new construction, rehabilitation, and redevelopment of real estate that promote the public health, safety and welfare of local citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus Kansas, that through its taxing authority, the City shall participate in the Cherokee County Revitalization Plan

NOW THEREFORE, This Resolution shall be effective upon passage subject to the approval of the Attorney General of Kansas. The resolution shall be published in the official City Newspaper.
