**A RESOLUTION BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS,
KANSAS, REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC HEALTH EMERGENCY,
AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF WALK-IN BUSINESS IN CITY HALL**

WHEREAS, the Covid-19 pandemic health emergency is an ongoing concern in Columbus, Kansas, with the number of positive cases, hospitalizations and deaths spiking locally and across the nation.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus has a duty to protect the health, safety and well-being of its employees, residents, customers and the general public.

WHEREAS, alternative methods of conducting business with the City provide effective means to communicate and conduct business with City Hall staff.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, that City Hall shall be closed to walk-in business to protect employees, residents, customers and the general public.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that residents and customers may readily conduct business with City Hall by utilizing its drive-thru, email, telephone or online access.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective upon passage by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, subject to further action by the Governing Body.
