

AMENDED RESOLUTION NO. 599

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNER, HIS OR HER AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF A STRUCTURE LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN, MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH STRUCTURE SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED AS AN UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS STRUCTURE.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 15th day of June, 2020, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the gray, single-occupancy, single story dwelling described herein, is unsafe and dangerous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:


That a hearing will be held on Monday, the 2nd day of November, 2020, before the Governing Body of the City at 6:45 p.m., at Columbus City Hall Council Chambers, 300 East Maple, Columbus, Kansas 66725, at which the owner, his or her agent, any lienholders of record, any occupant and any other parties in interest, as that term is defined by law, of the gray dwelling structure located at:

419 South Delaware Avenue, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, FIRST ADD CO, BLOCK 12, ALL LOT 5, LOT 4 EXC BEG SW COR LT 4 TH N10 E10 S10 W10 TO POB. Parcel ID# 011-136-13-0-30-30-011.00-0,


may appear and show cause why said gray dwelling should not be condemned as an unsafe or dangerous structure and ordered repaired or demolished and the debris removed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by law.
