ORDINANCE NO. 1475

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1100 REGARDING THE NON-EXCLUSIVE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE AWARDED TO COLUMBUS DATACENTRIC, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS.

WHEREAS, Columbus Datacentric, Inc., its successors and assigns are terminating cable television services to the City of Columbus, Kansas, causing Ordinance Number 1100 to become ineffective and without purpose.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: Ordinance Number 1100 shall be repealed at such time as all franchise fees owed to the City of Columbus, Kansas, according to Section 9 of the Ordinance, are paid in full.


SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
