ORDINANCE NO. 1477

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, UPDATING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER 8, BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION, ARTICLE VI, MOVING BUILDINGS, SECTION 8-522, BOND, INSURANCE REQUIRED, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: Code 2014, § 4-504; Code 2020; Section 8-522 shall be updated.

SECTION 2: New Sec. 8-522. - Bond, Insurance required.

(a) It shall be the duty of any person at the time of making application for a permit as provided in this article to give a good and sufficient surety bond to the city, to be approved by the city council, indemnifying the city against any loss or damage resulting from the failure of any such person to comply with the provisions of this article or for any damage or injury caused in moving any such house or structure. The bond herein shall be in the sum of \$5,000.00 or cash may be deposited in lieu of such surety bond.

(b) A blanket public liability insurance policy, issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the state, in the general aggregate amount of \$1,000,000.00.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
