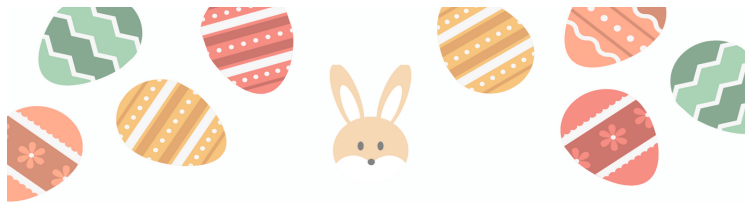
## 2021 SCHEDULE

Items must be placed at curb side or in alley, separated from your regular garbage, on designated days as City Crews **Will NOT** come back to pick up items. Divide items into like piles; wood, furniture, metal, etc. If not separated, items will not be picked up. Limbs may be taken to the Columbus Animal Shelter at 315 W. Cedar Street. **Ordinance No. 1184** prohibits anyone from going through and/or taking items set out for Fall Cleanup.


