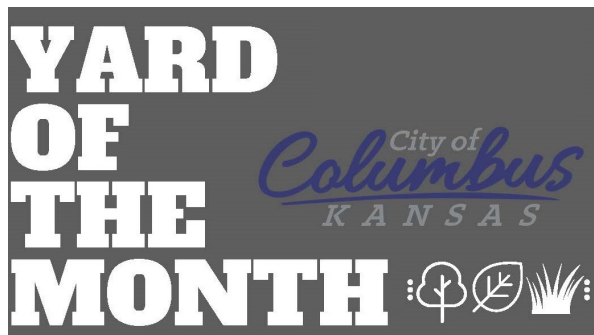

MOWING REQUIREMENTS

City Mowing Requirements

It's that time of year where the grass begins to grow. If a property owner allows weeds, grass, or uncultivated vegetation to grow higher than 12 inches, it can result in a penalty bill. Code Enforcement only sends out one violation notice to a property per calendar year. Property owners are responsible for grass/weeds/vegetation in abutting easements, ditches, alleys and rights-of-ways. If you see a yard that you believe is over the 12 inch allowance, please visit the Code Enforcement page on our website and submit a Property Code Violations Complaint Form.



Yard of the Month

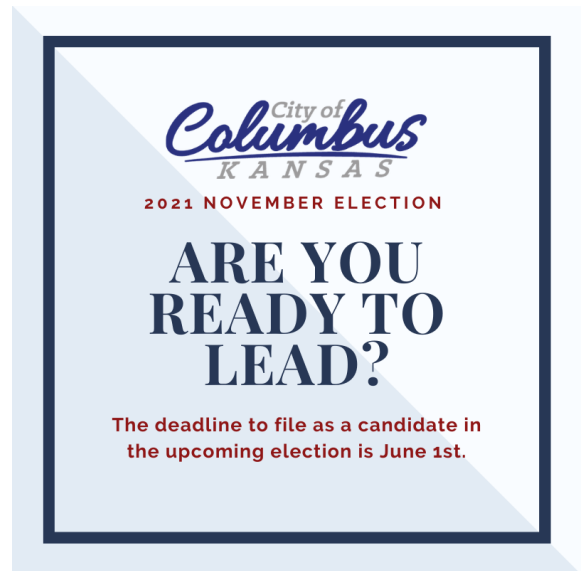
