

RESOLUTION NO. 606


A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 596, FINDING THAT THE STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 415 SOUTH INDIANA AVENUE, COLUMBUS, CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS, PARCEL NUMBER 011-136-13-0-30-29-009.00-0, DESCRIBED AS, FIRST ADD CO, BLOCK 11, LOT 5, HAS BEEN REPAIRED MAKING THE PREMISES MADE SAFE AND SECURE.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 15th of June 2020, file with the Governing Body of Columbus, Kansas, a statement in writing that a certain white, single-occupancy, two-story dwelling herein described, is dilapidated, unsafe and dangerous and a blight upon the neighborhood; and,


WHEREAS, on the 19th day of January 2021, the Enforcing Officer has reported to the Governing Body that the structure has been repaired to an extent that it is safe and secure and in compliance with the City Code.

BE IT RESOLVED the Governing Body hereby repeals Resolution No 596 and terminates its condemnation action.
