## **ORDINANCE NO. 1487**

## AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING TRAFFIC AND AUTHORIZING SIGNAGE FOR ONE-WAY TRAFFIC, EAST-TO-WEST, ON CROSSLAND LANE IN COLUMBUS, KANSAS, ON SATURDAY MORNINGS FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 1:00 P.M. DURING SOCCER SEASONS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1439.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance Number 1439 shall be amended.

**SECTION 2**. Due to increased traffic and safety concerns on Crossland Lane during soccer seasons, the Governing Body of Columbus, Kansas, directs that traffic on Crossland Lane shall be one-way, east-to-west, from North Riverside Drive to Twentieth (20th) Street every Saturday morning from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. during soccer seasons.

**SECTION 3**. The Property and Parks Department shall obtain and install appropriate signage at both intersections, North Riverside Drive and Crossland Lane, and Twentieth (20th) Street and Crossland Lane, directing one-way traffic east-to-west.

**<u>SECTION 4</u>**. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5**. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
