

RESOLUTION NO. 617

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNER, HIS OR HER AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF STRUCTURES LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN, MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH STRUCTURES SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED AS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS STRUCTURES.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 18th day of October, 2021, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the brick, single-occupancy, single story dwelling has extensive fire damage and is unsafe and dangerous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:


That a hearing will be held on the 6th day of December, 2021, before the Governing Body of the City at 6:45 p.m., at Columbus City Hall Council Chambers, 300 East Maple, Columbus, Kansas 66725, at which the owner, his or her agent, any lienholders of record, any occupant and any other parties in interest, as that term is defined by law, of the brick dwelling and attached and surrounding structures located at:


121 N. Illinois Avenue, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, Park Add Co, Block 13, Lot 1, E/2
2. Parcel ID # 011-136-13-0-10-28-001.00-0,

may appear and show cause why said brick dwelling and attached and surrounding structures should not be condemned as unsafe or dangerous structures and ordered repaired or demolished and the debris removed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by law.
