RESOLUTION NO. 621

A RESOLUTION OFFICIALLY NAMING THE CITY PARK AT 0 EAST PINE STREET, COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH KANSAS AVENUE AND EAST PINE STREET, TO BE DESIGNATED "DISCOVERY PARK," AND DESIGNATING THE NAME OF THE SLASH PAD FEATURE LOCATED ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF DISCOVERY PARK, "H AND H SPLASH PAD."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, controls and manages its City parks for the use and benefit to the public.

WHEREAS, the City park located at the southeast corner of the intersection of South Kansas Avenue and East Pine Street, Columbus, Kansas, is a park and recreation facility available for multiple uses to benefit the public.

WHEREAS, in recognition of the Houser and Hatfield families' generous contributions to the community, the Governing Body officially designates and names the splash pad feature located on the north side of Discovery Park, "H AND H SPLASH PAD."

SECTION 1. K.S.A. 12-101 *et. seq.*, and the Kansas Constitution authorize the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, to transact all City business and perform all powers of local legislation deemed appropriate, and to make all contracts and do all other acts in relation to the property and concerns of the City necessary to the exercise of its corporate or administrative powers.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to its statutory authority, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, hereby names the City park, located at the southeast corner of the intersection of South Kansas Avenue and East Pine Street, Columbus, Kansas, "DISCOVERY PARK," described as follows:


ORIGINAL PLAT CO, BLOCK 26, LOT 6 - 10

SECTION 3. Pursuant to its statutory authority, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, hereby names the splash pad feature located on the north side of Discovery Park, "H AND H SPLASH PAD"

SECTION 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
