

ARTICLE X HOLIDAYS WITH PAY

X -1 <u>Recognized City holidays</u>

The following days shall be holidays for all City employees in full-time positions who are in pay status the day before and the day after the recognized holidays:

New Year's Day – January 1 Martin Luther King's birthday – third Monday in January President's Day – third Monday in February Good Friday – Friday before Easter Memorial Day – last Monday in May Juneteenth – June 19 Independence Day – July 4 Labor Day – first Monday in September Columbus Day – second Monday in October Veterans Day – November 11 Thanksgiving Day and the day after – fourth Thursday and Friday in November Christmas Day – December 25

From time to time, on special occasions, the Mayor and City Council may designate other days as special holidays.

X – 2 Holiday falling on a Saturday or Sunday

When any regular holiday shall fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as a holiday. When any regular holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as a holiday.

X – 3 Computation of holiday pay

- A. Paid holiday time off is granted to all full-time employees upon hire.
- B. Full-time employees shall be paid for observed holidays calculated at the employee's straight-time base pay rate in the amount of eight (8) hours.
- C. A recognized City holiday that occurs during an employee's authorized vacation or sick leave shall not be counted as a day of vacation or sick leave.
- D. A holiday occurring between two (2) days of leave without pay shall not be paid.
- E. An employee must work (or be pre-approved for vacation leave or sick leave) the full scheduled workday before and the full scheduled workday after a holiday in order to be paid for the holiday.
- F. Holidays are not considered hours worked when calculating overtime pay.
