RESOLUTION NO. 646

A resolution by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, adopting the <u>2023 - 2027 Cherokee County Neighborhood Revitalization Plan</u> through an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Columbus, Kansas, and Cherokee County, Kansas.
