NEW BUSINESS

Discussion of Crossland Housing Initiative

City Administrator Jake Letner opened the discussion of a planned housing addition on the west side of the City of Columbus by introducing Liz Simpson of Crossland Construction. Simpson explained that Crossland Construction's housing project would consist of three stages, stage one being the construction of "starter homes" or "moderate income" homes. The need for housing and benefits of home ownership to the community was discussed as well as government grants that are currently available to developers. Simpson, on behalf of Crossland Construction, requested the council consider passing a resolution in support of the housing project which would aid Crossland in their grant application process.
