ORDINANCE NO. 1520

AN ORDINANCE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, ESTABLISHING TWO TIME-LIMITED PARKING SPACES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE TWO HUNDRED (200) BLOCK OF WEST MAPLE STREET IN COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, to accommodate the efficient flow of customers for businesses on the north side of the two hundred (200) block of West Maple Street in Columbus, Kansas, two (2) parking spaces shall be designated as fifteen (15) minute, time-limited spaces, with potential penalties for violators.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Two (2) parking spaces shall be designated as fifteen (15) minute, time-limited parking spaces on the north side of the two hundred (200) block of West Maple Street in Columbus, Kansas between the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

SECTION 2. The City Superintendent shall evaluate and determine the location of the two (2) time-limited spaces and have appropriate signage installed.

SECTION 3. Penalty. Failure to comply with the time-limited parking may result in a citation being issued and assessment of a fine.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
